PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING:

- 1 This declaration covers any donations made prior to this year, this donation and any future donations you may make to Thrombosis UK but please:
 - [a] Notify Thrombosis UK if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.
 - [b] You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the charity - it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of the cancellation or such later date as you specify.
- 2 I confirm that I have paid or will pay an amount of income tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6 April one year to 5 April the next) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that all charities or CASC's reclaim on my donations in the appropriate tax year. I understand that Council Tax and VAT do not qualify.
- 3 If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and/or capital gains at least equal to the tax all charities or CASC's reclaim, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
- 4 Thrombosis UK will reclaim
 - [a] 28p of tax on every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.
 - [b] 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008.
